



MINUTES OF REVIEW MEETING OF “24 X 7 POWER FOR ALL” HELD ON 22.01.2018

A review meeting of “24 x 7 Power For All” was held under the chairmanship of Joint Secretary (Distribution), Ministry of Power in Conference room, 2nd floor, Shram Shakti Bhawan, Rafi Marg, New Delhi on 22.01.2018 through video conference in respect of all States / UT’s. The list of participants is at **Annex**. At the outset, Joint Secretary (Distribution) welcomed all the members.

2. The important points discussed are as under.

2.1 JS (Distribution) informed that in the last Power Minister’s conference, Hon’ble Minister of Power discussed with all the States and it was agreed that States/UTs should work towards achieving 24 x 7 Power for all by March 2019 as per the PFA document.

2.2 JS (Distribution) requested the States to review all the parameters in different sectors Generation, Transmission, Distribution, Renewable Energy etc and accordingly plan the infrastructure required to achieve 24 X 7 Power for All.

2.3 JS (Distribution) requested the States to provide the details about the Power Supply position in the States. The details of Power Supply position in the States informed by the Representatives is as under:

S.No.	State	Hours of Supply	Remarks
1	Uttarakhand	Urban - 23.45 Hrs Rural - 23.40 Hrs	The representative of the State informed that the power supply was improving gradually and there is no shortage of power in the State. He also informed that the Hours of supply is less than 24 hrs to schedule for implementation of works under Central Govt. Schemes.
2	West Bengal	Urban – 23.7 Hrs Rural – 23.5 Hrs (including Agriculture consumers)	The representative of the State informed that the mandate of the State is to provide 24 Hrs supply.
3	Gujarat	Urban – 24 Hrs Rural – 24 Hrs	
4	Maharashtra	Urban - 24 Hrs Rural – 24 Hrs except Agriculture consumers	
5	Telangana	Urban – 24 Hrs Rural – 24 Hrs (including Agriculture consumers)	The representative of the State informed that from 1 st Jan 2018 State is extending 24 Hrs power Supply to Agriculture consumers also.
6	Punjab	Urban – 24 Hrs Rural – 24 Hrs Agriculture – 8 Hrs	The representative of the State informed that State is surplus in supply.
