MINUTES OF REVIEW MEETING OF "24 X 7 POWER FOR ALL" HELD ON 04.04.2016

A review meeting of "24 x 7 Power For All" was held under the chairmanship of Secretary (Power), Ministry of Power in Conference room, 2nd floor, Shram Shakti Bhawan, Rafi Marg, New Delhi on 04.04.2016. The list of participants is at **Annex**. At the outset, Joint Secretary (Power) welcomed all the members and apprised Secretary (Power) regarding the steps being taken to achieve the objectives of "24 x 7 Power For All" program. ED (T&D), REC gave a presentation regarding the web portal developed by CPMU for monitoring the progress of activities covered under "24 x 7 Power For All" program and achievements of states to meet program goals. The State-wise contact details of CPMU officials for 24X PFA Monitoring is at **Annex-I**.

2. During the presentation, the following points were discussed:

- i. ED (T&D) informed that all the aspects of Power sector covered in the Power For All documents have been mapped in the portal and rollout plans for all the states are being captured by the CPMU in the web portal.
- ii. Joint Secretary (Distribution) emphasized on the role of states in filling up progress on the portal on regular basis for effective monitoring of the program.
- iii. Secretary (Power) advised the states to appoint the nodal officers for the program, who will be responsible for updating data in the web portal. In this regard Joint Secretary (Transmission) suggested that states may appoint the same nodal officers who were involved in document preparation as nodal officers for updating the progress data on web portal. It was decided that the states should ensure that the data in web portal should be updated by 10th of every month.

- iv. ED (T&D) also informed that the login credentials for the web portal have been generated for respective states and the contact details of the members of CPMU are also being shared and states can feel free to contact the CPMU members in case of any issue regarding web portal. State-wise contact details of CPMU officials is given at Annexure-I.

- v. It was decided to organize workshop for the nodal officer and dealing officials of the States on the functioning of 24X7 web portal. One workshop to be carried out for the 18 States who have already signed PFA agreement. Another workshop will be carried out for the balance States and UTs.
