## **Minutes of the Meeting held on 20.06.2018 of the Central Programme Monitoring Unit (CPMU) for '24X7 Power for All' Mission at Shram Shakti Bhawan, New Delhi**

A meeting was held under the chairmanship of Joint Secretary (Distribution) to review the working of Central Programme Monitoring Unit (CPMU) in order to achieve the targets of 24 x7 Power For All (PFA) program. The list of participants attached at Annex.

1. JS (Distribution) informed that significant measures are being taken by the Government through various schemes like DDUGJY, IPDS, UDAY and Saubhagya to improve the situation of Power sector in the country. Ministry of Power (MoP) is aiming to ensure 24 x 7 Power Supply and is very keen in timely implementation of the program. Accordingly, the PFA cell at MoP has been strengthened.
2. He added that as the time line for implementing the 'Power for All' program is coming closer, it is necessary to evaluate the preparedness of States to provide 24x7 Power supply w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019. In this regard, he advised the CPMU members to analyse "availability" vs "actual requirement" for key sectors like Generation, Inter State and Intra State Transmission. To carry out the analysis, three small groups should be formed and assistance will be sought from Generation and Transmission wings of CEA and system operation wing of POSOCO.
3. It was also decided to exclude those Union Territories and States from monitoring which have already achieved the target of 24x7 Power Supply.
4. He asked the CEA representative to deploy more man power in CPMU/PFA activities. Further, he also instructed the CPMU members to contribute actively towards achieving the targets of program.
5. He also reviewed the status of the Power For All (PFA) portal and asked the members to come up with more effective strategy to achieve the monitoring of 24 x7 power availability in the country. He also asked the members to explore the possibility of developing an App from crowd sourcing data on hours of power supply/shut-down in different parts of the country.
6. He also suggested REC representatives to strengthen manpower and logistics in the CPMU cell and may submit a proposal for fund requirements, if any to MoP. It was also mentioned that Shri Abhinesh Pasula Sr. Executive, REC and Shri Tarun Khattar, Manager, NHPC should be exclusively deployed to carry out the task of CPMU, since Mr. Khattar had been deputed to REC for the tasks of CPMU only.
7. It was decided that MoP will issue order reconstituting the CPMU.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
